The District Church will transition to Lake Shore's campus on October 18th. Upon their transition, we will move our church service to 11:00 a.m.

The District Church will use our Sunday School hour for their Children's program. Lake Shore's Sunday School hour for our children will be incorporated with their Children's program. I am encouraging our teachers to be trained and work with all the teachers of The District Church.

Lake Shore will continue to have Children's Church during our worship hour. I encourage all the Sunday School teachers and children's leaders to be involved in the Children's Church during our 11:00 a.m. worship hour.

Our Sunday School will resume October 4th. All adult and youth classes will remain the same: **9:15 am. Adult Teachers:** you will be in the places that you had before, unless you want to change location, see Debbie Haskell. Preschool and Children classes will resume October 18th at 9:30 am **(with 9:15 early arrival activities).**

The District Church will have their worship hour starting at 9:30 a.m. and ending around 10:30 am. (you and I know that as the Holy Spirit leads, the service may be a little longer). Lake Shore will start worship at 11:00 am.

PLEASE REMEMBER:

1. Even though The District Church will be on our campus, they are their own church. They do not tell us what to do and we do not tell them what to do: in relation to how each of our churches operate.
2. We do have the final say so in any changes that are needed. These changes must show benefit to Lake Shore as well as The District Church. These changes will go through the Church Council for review and approval.
3. The District Church will be invited to our outreach events and our weekly missional activities. If they want to be part of them, that will be a great thing. So will Lake Shore be invited to theirs.
4. This is something that very few churches have been successful at doing. We (Lake Shore and The District Church) want to work ridiculously hard so that our two churches will come together, sharing the facilities and our strengths, at the same time building up each other's weaknesses to make a model for other churches to follow.

BOTTOM LINE: THE GOAL IS TO WIN JACKSONVILLE TO THE LORD!!!!
